5. 補會後或利用了那項活動作為補會，請向秘書長呈報。此告。






# Fun with Attendance

It is fun for me as the Sergeant-at-Arms to report attendance figure at meetings after our new member Chow Chee was inducted. As our total active membership became 22, the attendance figures always ended with two recurring decimals:

11 members	<b>50.000000000...%</b>	17 members	<b>77.2727272727...%</b>
12 members	<b>54.5454545454...%</b>	18 members	<b>81.8181818181...%</b>
13 members	<b>59.0909090909...%</b>	19 members	<b>86.3636363636...%</b>
14 members	<b>63.6363636363...%</b>	20 members	<b>90.9090909090...%</b>
15 members	<b>68.1818181818...%</b>	21 members	<b>95.4545454545...%</b>
16 members	<b>72.7272727272...%</b>	22 members	<b>100.0000000000...%</b>

This sounds interesting, especially when the two recurring decimals of each figure are multiples of 9. A mathematician can easily point out (and prove) this number pattern when numbers are divided by 11. Since 22 is a multiple of 11, the series of numbers will naturally have similar pattern. The same applies to 33, 44 and so on.

If one finds it troublesome to report the never-ending decimals, we have to increase our membership to 25. Then each member constitutes 4% and attendance figure of each meeting bear no decimal.

On the other hand, if one finds it amusing to report recurring decimals in attendance figures, we better aim for a membership of 27, as all attendance figures will then have three recurring decimals:



#### PAUL HARRIS - FIRST BUT NOT FIRST

Was Paul Harris the first president of a Rotary club? No.

Was Paul Harris the first president of Rotary International? Yes.

There is an easy explanation to this apparent contradiction. Although Paul Harris was the founder and organizer of the first Rotary club in Chicago in 1905, the man selected to be the first president was one of the other founding members, Silvester Schiele.

By the year 1910 there were 16 Rotary clubs, which linked up as an organization called the National Association of Rotary Clubs. A couple of years later the name was changed to International Association of Rotary Clubs as Rotary was organized in Winnipeg, Canada, and then in England, Ireland and Scotland. In 1922 the name was shortened to Rotary International.


When the first organization of Rotary clubs was created in 1910, Paul Harris was selected as the first president. He served in this position for two years, from 1910 until 1912. Thus, the founder of the Rotary idea, who declined to be president of the first club, became the first president of the worldwide organization, Rotary International.
